

Did you know? On-street, City-owned and privately-owned parking lots within the downtown core offer more than 4,500 parking stalls. Look for the "blue car" signage to help you find your way to the many available parking lots downtown.





Parking information

Free parking?

You bet. Most Cityowned parking lots and two parkades are free on evenings and weekends (except events).

Pay by phone...

All City parking locations downtown now offer Pay by Phone. Set up an account by calling 1-866-234 -7275 or visit paybyphone.com.

Mind your time...

Please remember that time limits range from 30 minutes to 8 hours for all on-street spaces. If you need more time consider using a lot or parkade.

RV parking...

RV, oversized and bus parking is permitted in all metered lots; but ensure you pay for each occupied stall.

Or leave the car, take the bike...

From Mission...

Shared pathways on Gordon Drive to the Barrera/Casorso path will take you to Lakeshore Road, to Abbott Street and to the underpass at the highway.

Trip time: 30 minutes

Want a more direct route? Try the Richter Street bike lanes.

From Rutland...

or more northerly points, the Leathead Road bike lanes link directly to bike lanes on Enterprise Way leading to the Rails with Trails path at Dilworth and onward to Cawston Avenue paths into downtown. Trip time: 30 minutes

From Glenmore Rd...

Take the High/ Clifton bike lanes and cross Clement Avenue onto Rails with Trails and Cawston Avenue pathways into downtown.

Trip time: 15 minutes

From Capri area...

Head up Sutherland Avenue onto the new path linking the Dayton St. overpass to Angel Way and onward to Rails with Trails and Cawston Avenue paths into downtown.

Trip time: 20 minutes

From Okanagan College...

Ethel Street offers a low traffic route and direct connections from KSS and Okanagan College. Trip time: 15 minutes




Ten transit routes converge in the heart of downtown Kelowna at the upgraded Queensway Transit Exchange. You can travel by transit in and out of downtown to almost every area of the city and region with direct routes to UBCO, Rutland, Glenmore, South Pandosy, Lower Mission, the North End, Orchard Park, Westbank First Nation (WFN) and West Kelowna.

Connections can be made at other transit stops in the city and region for travel to outlying areas such as Peachland, Lake Country, various West Kelowna and WFN neighborhoods, Kelowna International Airport, Upper Mission, East Kelowna, Black Mountain and Dilworth Mtn. The #97 Okanagan Rapid Bus line provides fast, direct service to many major destinations along Hwy 97.
